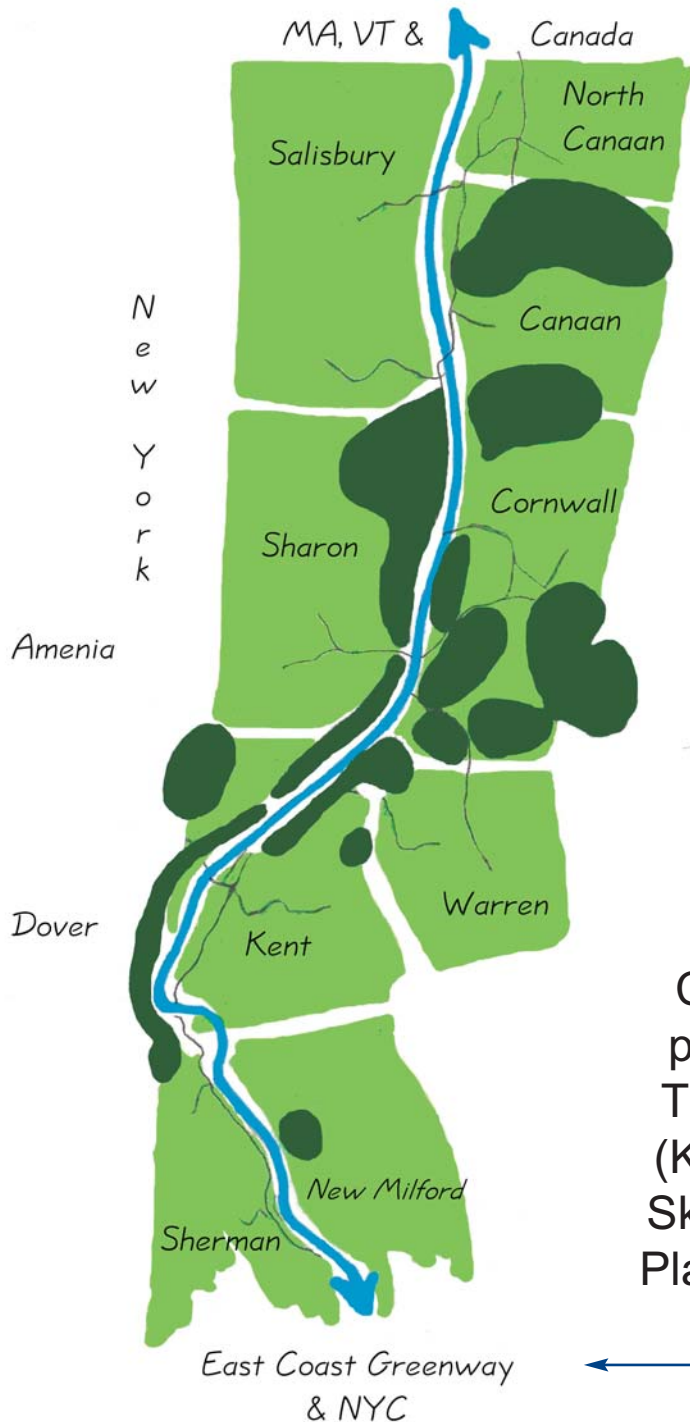


Housatonic Covered Bridge Bike Trail



The “Houbike Trail” will run on low volume, low speed river roads along the Housatonic River.

The trail, when fully marked, will cover nearly 30 miles, and will connect Sheffield, MA with Kent, CT.

Numerous loop and spur trails will provide additional opportunity to ride, and will connect the central trail to many village centers and heritage sites.
